The Outstanding Achievement Award is granted to a member who has made significant and exceptional contributions to psychiatry, has earned the respect and admiration of the greater community, and has made a significant impact upon colleagues and upon the character and delivery of psychiatric services.

The Presidents' Distinguished Service Award is granted annually by former presidents to a member for long-standing and devoted service to the Society.

The Meritorious Service Award honors a lifetime of distinguished service to the field of psychiatry and may be granted annually to an NCPS member in recognition of contributions at the local, state and/or national level.

The Committee Person of the Year Award is given by the President to the committee chair or member who has made an outstanding contribution to committee work on behalf of the Society, and who has demonstrated leadership, mentorship and stimulation of teamwork in committee activities. The contribution of time, energy, devotion, skill, enthusiasm and efficiency are considered, as well as the importance of committee projects to the objectives of the Society.

Formerly the Special Award, the **Geri Taylor Memorial Award** may be given to a non-member who has made special contributions to the Society and its purposes in the form of time, energy and expertise above and beyond the call of duty. The recipient may have been paid for service by NCPS. The award may also be viewed as one given in recognition of scientific, clinical, research or theoretical contributions to psychiatry and/or related mental health disciplines.

The Media Award recognizes an outstanding journalist or media broadcaster who within the past year (or years) brought to the attention of the public through his or her professional work issues related to mental health or mental illness with sensitivity, objectivity and social responsibility. This award is granted periodically, only when such an outstanding journalist or media broadcaster is evident.
