Instructions:

Your room will need to be reserved and secured with your credit card ahead of time during the room block window, which is open through February 20th. Once you have made the reservation, please email Adrienne at info@ncps.org to confirm and list the names of resident fellow members staying in the room.

Once you have checked into the conference and completed the conference evaluation, NCPS will have your room charge credited to our account and any room fees/taxes will be removed from your credit card (*this does not include any incidentals charged during your stay*).

You may reserve your room at the room block rate of \$229 before February 20th or until the block is full [HERE](#) or by calling 1-888-222-5851 and mentioning the NCPS Conference block. Block rate is subject to sell out.

Please plan to attend the conference if you register and make hotel reservations as our room block is limited and we need appropriate numbers for food & beverage orders. You will be responsible for room charges if you fail to attend the conference or cancel in time.
