UPDATED INFORMATION (February 11, 2019)

NCPS strives to include and support their resident members to help enhance their personal and professional growth and foster networking with veteran members and leaders in the field. One way we do this is by offering FREE or reduced registration fees to conferences, CME, and networking events.

Due to an overwhelming response in registrations from residents for the NCPS Annual Meeting, we have had to cap the free and \$25 registration fees and room reimbursement. Below is the current pricing and lodging information for the conference:

You may reserve rooms on the NCPS room block at \$229 per night (plus fees & taxes)

As mentioned above, we have reached our limit on reimbursable rooms for residents. NCPS does set aside money for each residency program to utilize for mixers and networking events. Each program has \$1000 for use in 2019. Your program can discuss and decide whether to put some of these funds towards more room reimbursements for residents and/or conference registrations fees. This would need to be agreed upon and communicated through your NCPS Resident Representative and is available on a first come, first served basis as appropriated by your program. Rooms would still need to be reserved and secured with your credit card and reimbursement issued after the conference based on approval from program and funds available.

Please plan to attend the conference if you register and make hotel reservations, as our room block is limited, and we need appropriate numbers for food & beverage orders. You will be responsible for room charges if you fail to attend or cancel in time.
